3. **IN BRIEF –**

- Review Group Update – Revised RSP Terms of Reference  
Mrs. Karen Edwards reported that the review group had met a couple of times and had reviewed the terms of reference. The revised terms of reference were distributed. Mrs. Edwards asked that any comments or issues were reported back to her.
- Hampshire Local Area Agreement Update  
Mr. Andrew Lloyd updated the Partnership on the LAA. He reported that the 33 indicators had been agreed and signed off. Mr. Lloyd outlined the indicators and highlighted some as being of particular interest. A guide had been produced by the County Council and was available on the Hampshire LAA website. Peter Moyle added that the first meeting had been held on 10th September 2008 and future meetings were scheduled for November 2008, January 2009 and March 2009. The Partnership noted that agendas for each of these meetings had already been distributed to enable good

preparation and meaningful contributions to each meeting. Cllr. Moyle added that the aim of the Senate was to encourage joined up thinking and to date it had been effective in achieving this aim.

A briefing paper was distributed. Mrs. Edwards reported that Rushmoor Borough Council were working on an internal approach.
